The upcoming General Assembly session shapes up to be another challenging one. This is the perfect opportunity to educate your elected officials on important issues that impact your firm, and the need to:

- *Further strengthen the state’s current Indemnification Law to make a “Duty to Defend” requirement illegal.*
- *Greatly reduce the prohibition on submitting a proposal that applies to an individual or the firm that hires the individual if the individual assisted the state in drafting specifications or RFP that is used on that project.*
- *Defeat efforts to raid money from accounts dedicated for infrastructure funding.*
- *Reject efforts to apply sales tax to engineering and related services.*
